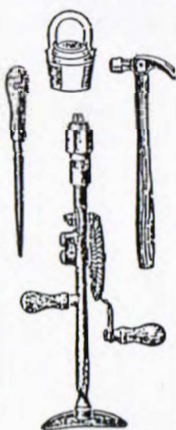
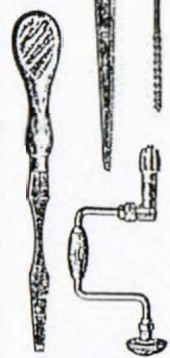
Any deviation from the model parameters is to be described, whether positive or negative. All tools Good - or better are assumed useable unless specific problems are pointed out.
